

Charlotte Radiology Doctor Awarded Highest State- level Professional Honor

CHARLOTTE, — Dr. Arl Van Moore Jr. received the Silver Medal Award from the North Carolina Radiological Society at an April 12 award ceremony in Chapel Hill. Moore is an Interventional Radiologist and President of Charlotte Radiology.

The Silver Medal Award is given to physicians for their extraordinary service to the North Carolina Chapter of the American College of Radiology. It is the highest honor of that the North Carolina Radiological Society gives. Moore is the tenth recipient of the award, which is only presented as it is deemed deserved.

Ranked as Radiology's fourth most powerful person in 2007 by *RT Image Magazine*, Moore is one of the nation's most respected leaders in the field of Radiology. He is the current Chairman of the Board of Chancellors of the American College of Radiology and serves as medical director at the Carolinas Medical Center School of Radiologic Technology. Moore is also an interventional radiology CAQ examiner for the American Board of Radiology and a clinical assistant professor at the Duke University Medical Center Department of Radiology.
